

Benefits of Improved Lighting In the Workplace



A direct reduction in lighting costs. The Lockheed plant in Seattle, WA reduced annual lighting costs by \$500,000 and increased employee productivity by 15% (ErgoDynamix, 2001).

An increase in employee productivity. At West Bend Mutual Insurance, they recorded a 16% increase in productivity due to a lighting upgrade (ErgoDynamix, 2001).

An improvement in employee well-being that usually reduces absenteeism and improves employee retention. According to the Steelcase Workplace Survey, 86% of employees say that making lighting improvements to the workplace would reduce eyestrain and headaches (Steelcase Workplace Survey, 1999).

Good lighting can decrease errors by 30-60%. Workers can produce more products with fewer mistakes, an increase in productivity of 10-50% (*Lighting in the Workplace*, 2003).
